MAILBOX REPAIRS – MAY 15 DEADLINE

Most Plum Creek North homeowners have spiffed up their mailbox and mailbox post within the past year or so. **Those who have yet to get the post painted or replaced, and where needed, the mailbox replaced, HAVE UNTIL MAY 15.** After that date, the board will arrange to have work done and an invoice sent to you.

Section 6 of the covenants shows that the HOA sets the type and design. The post color is "sagebrush" found at Sherwin-Williams. A mailbox should be **powder-coated beige**, with **cocoa colored vinyl text in Medium Caxton** font. The mailbox should be these colors, on an **upright post, free of rust, with doors and flags in good working order.**
