# Easy Steps to Lower Electric Bills this Summer

Cooling our homes in an Indiana summer can be expensive. In addition to having your HVAC system serviced by a professional and replacing filters, there are a few simple steps to help your home remain cooler and be less expensive, too.

Close A/C vents to rooms you are not using or for rooms that are too cold.

Use curtains, shutters, shades or window films to reduce the sunshine coming in your windows. One website recommends closing all window treatments on the south and west sides of your home and leaving the thermostat at 85 when you are gone.

If you don't already have one **consider a programmable thermostat**.

**Use fans.** If you raise your thermostat and add fans to move air, you are likely to pay less overall. Several websites suggest 78 degrees for a thermostat setting when using fans.

Install compact fluorescent lightbulbs and turn off anything that generates heat even when not in use.
