NORTH RANGE LINE ROAD PROJECT

Beginning on or after August 3, road improvements will begin to
North Range Line Road - from 8th Street (Smokey Row) to Clay
Terrace.

Improvements include: Roundabout retrofit, storm water drainage,
and pedestrian paths.

There are two stages to this project:

Stage 1 - A retrofit of the existing roundabout. "Work crews will be
making modifications to the outside curb lanes in order to improve
traffic flow through the roundabout. During this phase, the
intersection of 8th and Range Line will be closed to through-traffic
in all four directions." This stage should be completed by August
14th, when schools open.

Stage 2 - Includes an installation of a new storm water collection
system and pedestrian connectivity from the roundabout to a point
just south of Clay Terrace. This project is expected to last until
